MARIACHI II, III & IV WORKSHOPS

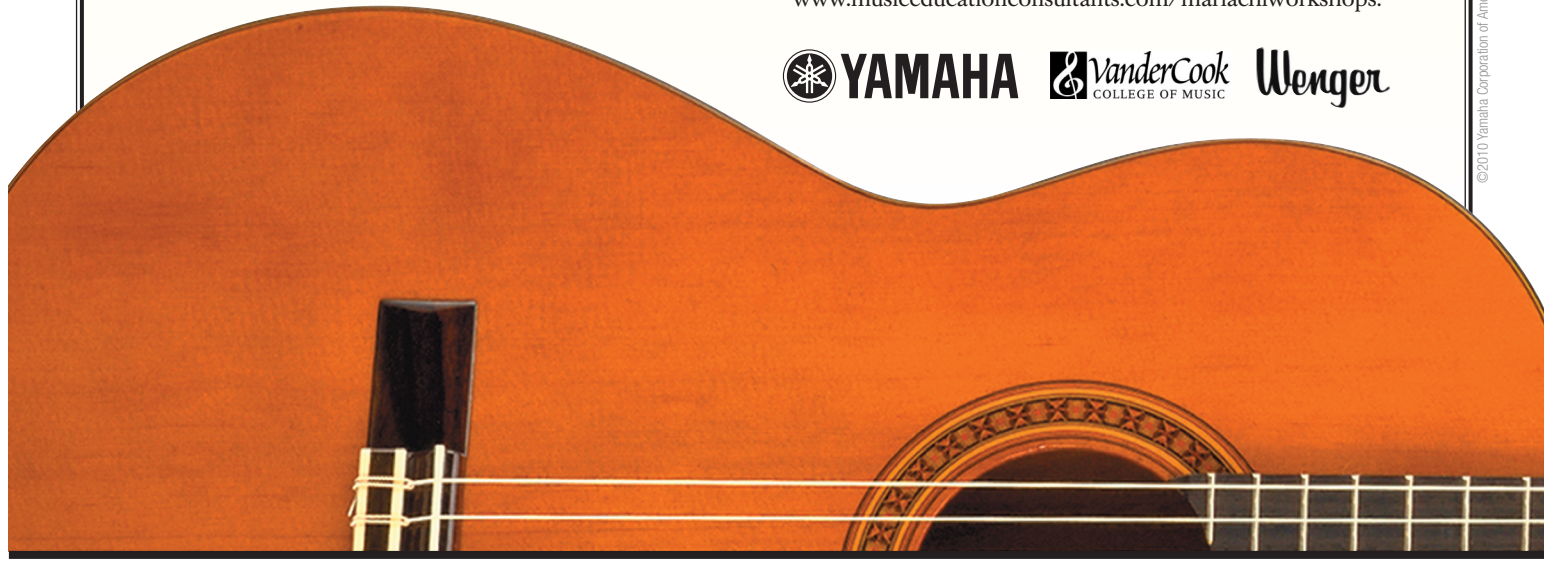
